**PRELIMINARY RESULTS OF SPELEOMYCOLOGICAL RESEARCH  
IN THE HISTORICAL ADIT IN JANOWIEC (LOWER SILESIA, SW POLAND)**

In Lower Silesia (SW Poland) the systematic speleomycological investigations are carried out in old underground mining workings. In a historic adit in Janowiec near Bardo Śląskie a domination of fungi of the genus *Penicillium* (in the air) and *Geomyces pannorum* and *Aspergillus niger* (on the rock) has been documented. These organisms are potentially dangerous for the historical elements and equipment of the adit, but do not pose a threat to people staying in the excavation.
